Color Index by Jim Krause includes over 1,100 color combinations.

The eleven chapters cover Basics, Active, Quiet, Progressive, Rich, Muted, Culture/Era, Natural, Accent, Logo Ideas and Browser Safe. Within each chapter you will find one or more groups of colors or palettes. You can simply fan the page edges if you which to quickly move to a given grouping of colors.

CMYK (cyan, magenta, yellow, black) and RGB (red, green, blue) formulas have been provided in ten chapters, with HEX (hexadecimal) and RGB values available in the eleventh. The HEX and CMYK might seem relevant outside of the fiber world, but if you wanted to take something from CMYK to HEX, the book and a website might assist you in getting there.

I had hoped that the book might help me in planning a weaving project that uses nine colors, so that I could change the palette to one more suitable to me (and make use of at least some of the cones of fiber I already have), but it was beyond me, and possibly the book.

While the book does contain lots of color combinations, I think the most that I ever saw was four. Perhaps I could choose a few pages, add in the colors I have at home, and TBD.

Dizzy Spinning group: things have seemed to get in the way for the spinners group these last few months. In January we will be starting to study and learn how to spin boucles and move into art and fantasy yarns. Come learn something new.

TEN MINUTE MICROWWAVE CARAMELS

INGREDIENTS:

1/2 butter

1/2 cup light corn syrup

1/2 cup light brown sugar

1/2 cup white sugar

1/2 cup sweetened condensed milk

1 teaspoon vanilla

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Butter an 8-inch square pan. If you like you can then line the buttered pan with foil and buttered the foe;.
- 2. Melt butter in a large microwaveable bowl (microwave for about 1 minute).
- 3. Stir in corn syrup, both sugars and sweetened condensed milk stirring until most of the sugar is dissolved.
- 4. Microwave on high for 3 minutes 15 seconds. Remove and stir and scrape down the sides of the bowl.
- 5. Return to microwave and cook on high for another 3 minutes 15 seconds. Stir in the vanilla.
- 6. Pour immediately into buttered dish.
- 7. Allow to sit for several hours until cooled. Cut into squares and wrap in waxed paper.
