Vogue Knitting Chunky Scarves & Hats On the Go includes twenty-four chunky knitting patterns or pairs of patterns (i.e., a hat and a scarf, rather than one or the other). Though I've never done a "chunky knit," I can certainly see the appeal of being able to turn out a project in such a short time, and I always like projects such as scarves, because they always fit! Right up my alley.

This book takes you through the basics (though do come to it knowing how to knit), including sizing, construction, gauge, yarn selection, yarn substitution, following charts, color work knitting, blocking, finishing, sewing, and care. There are directions for making a variety of hats and scarves. Each comes with a color photograph, and in most cases the directions are one fairly compact page in length.

Though I don't think that children and scarves go together, there is a cute "Kid's Scarf; A Bug's Life" that could be used as a fun room decoration.
